Dispatchers Cheri Barker and Lindsay Payton decided to take on the project of “Gone but Not Forgotten” so the patch could be displayed. Letters were sent to police and fire agencies all over Washington state requesting patches to commemorate fallen officers and firefighters. As SNOCOM was established in 1971, it was decided that would be the beginning year for our memorial.

SNOCOM now houses the “Gone but Not Forgotten” memorial wall in which all agencies that have lost a police officer or firefighter in the line of duty since 1971 will be remembered forever.
